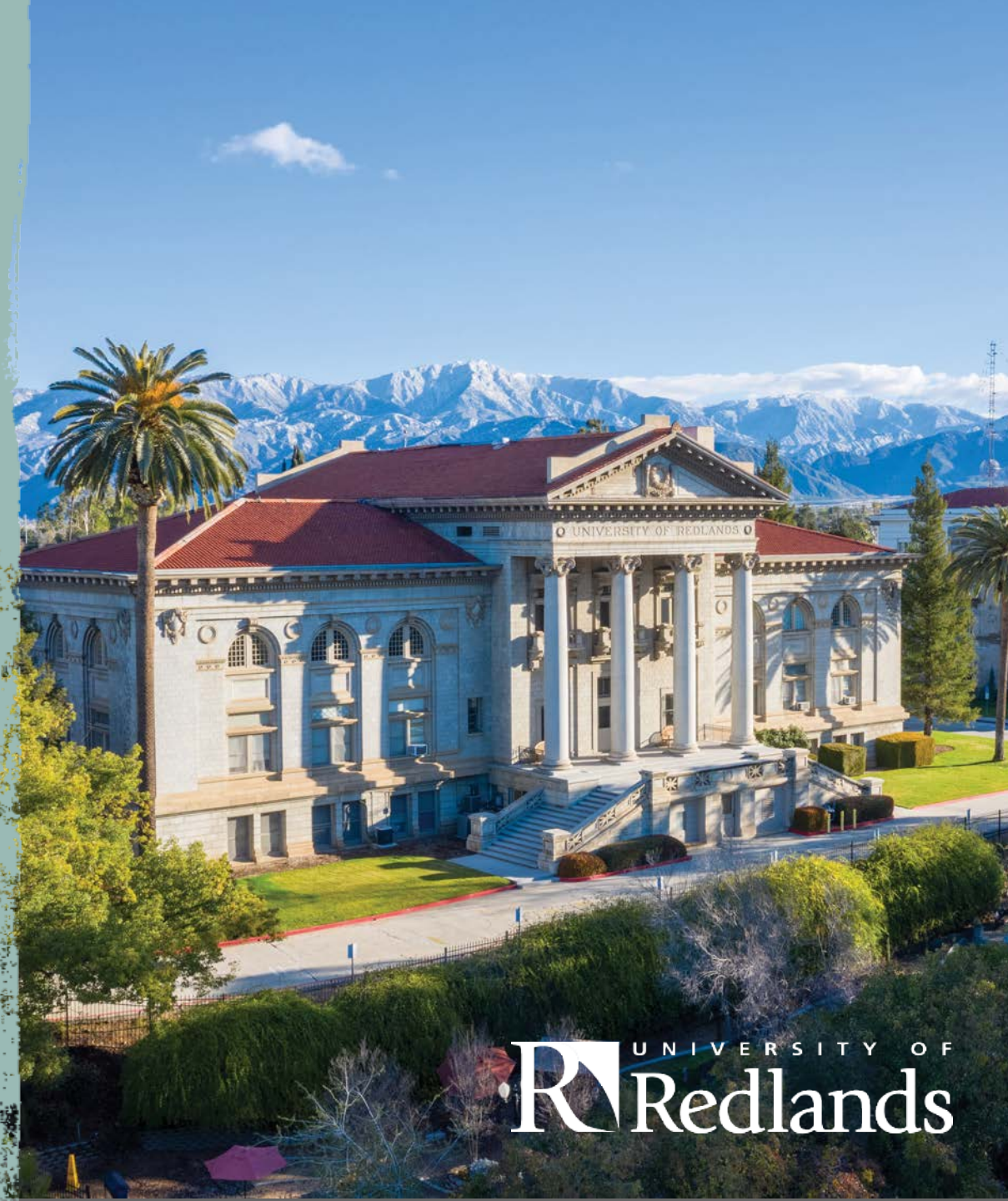

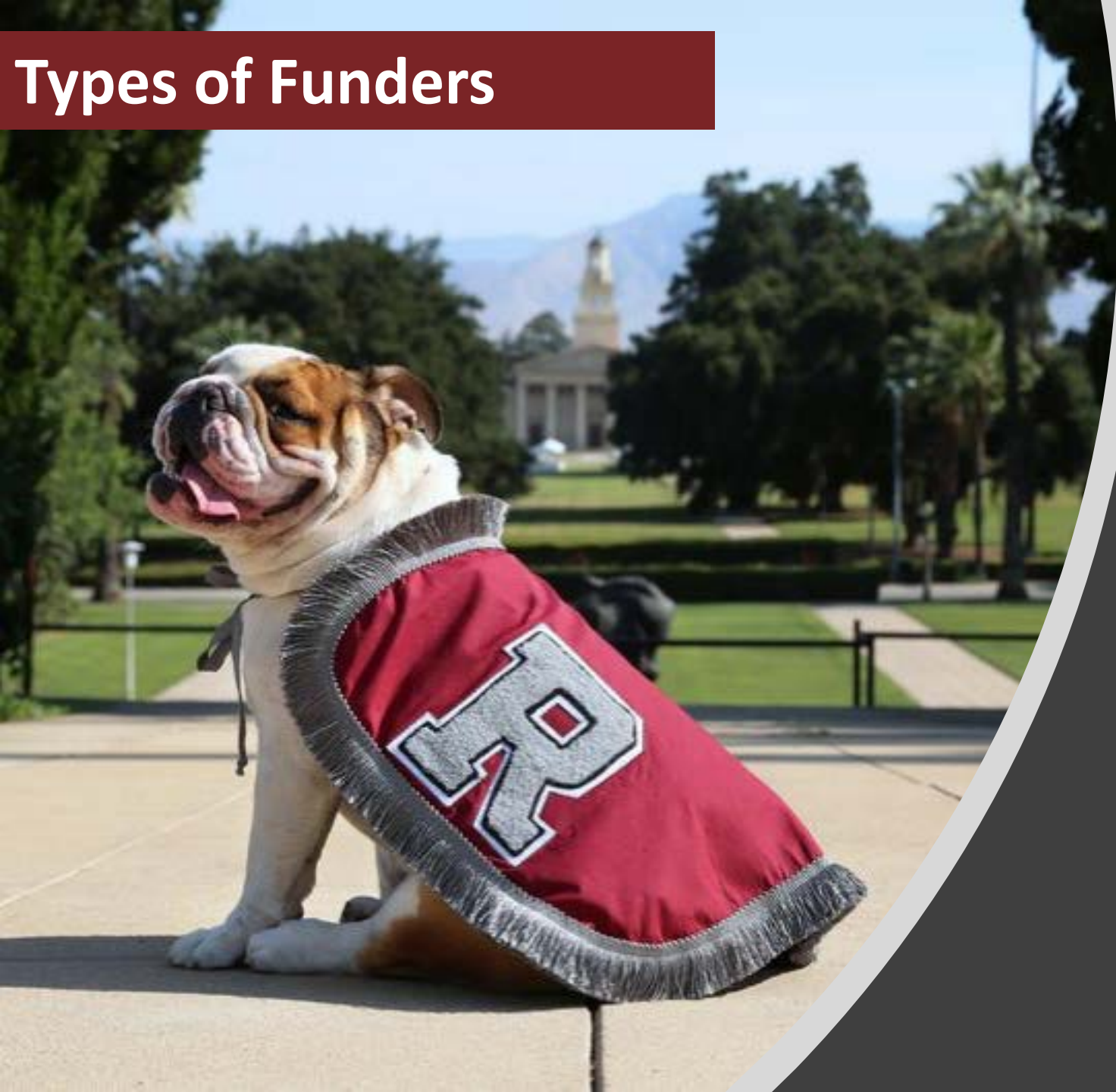

BULLDOG PROPOSAL DEVELOPMENT PROCESS



Consult

Bring your proposal idea to the Sponsored Programs Office. Refine your project idea and find sources of funding.



Develop

Write your proposal narrative. Receive feedback. Develop a project budget and justification. Assemble forms, letters, and other supporting documents.



Route

Complete a proposal routing form and route the form, budget, budget justification, and project summary through the Sponsored Programs Office, a dean or the Provost, and the Vice President for Finance/Chief Financial Officer.



Submit

Submit your proposal. Most proposals are submitted by the Sponsored Programs Office on behalf of the University.

How to Begin

Proposal development takes time, coaching, and practice. The more you write proposals, the better you get at it. Perseverance is a key to success. Rejection is part of the process. You learn from formulating and submitting proposals, getting feedback from reviewers and program officers, refining your idea, and submitting again. If successful, upon you, your proposal is funded and then you must face the prospect of implementing and managing a project.

When you have an idea for a research or instructional project, contact the Sponsored Programs Office. We will help you turn your idea into a fundable project proposal. The following steps happen during your initial consultations:

1. We will ask you to describe your project idea as well as any efforts you have made to secure funding in the past. Reviewing a one-page description or previous

[Assistance for Arts Education \(AAE\) Program](#). Due March 16, 2021. The AAE program promotes arts education for students, including disadvantaged students and students who are children with disabilities, through activities such as (a) professional development for arts educators, teachers, and principals; (b) development and dissemination of accessible instructional materials and arts-based educational programming, including online resources, in multiple arts disciplines; and (c) community and national outreach activities that strengthen and expand partnerships among schools, local educational agencies (LEAs), communities, or centers for the arts, including national centers for the arts.

[Education Research](#). Due February 25, 2021. The National Center for Education Research supports rigorous research that contributes to the solution of significant education problems in the United States. Through its research initiatives and the national research and development centers, NCER engages in research activities that will result in the provision of high quality education for all children, improvement in student academic achievement, reduction in the achievement gap between high-performing and low-performing students, and increased access to and opportunity for postsecondary education. NCER research examines the effectiveness of educational programs, practices, and policies, including the application of technology to instruction and assessment. The goal of NCER research programs is to provide scientific evidence of what works, for whom, and under what conditions. NCER also supports training programs to prepare individuals to conduct rigorous and relevant education research that advances knowledge within the field and addresses issues important to education policymakers and practitioners.

Office of Postsecondary Education (OPE): [Fulbright-Hays Group Projects Abroad \(GPA\) Program Long-Term Project Assistance](#). Due March 15, 2021. The purpose of the Fulbright-Hays GPA Program is to promote, improve, and develop the study of modern foreign languages and area studies in the United States. The program provides opportunities for faculty, teachers, and undergraduate and graduate students to conduct individual and group projects overseas. Projects may include either (1) short-term seminars, curriculum development, group research or study, or (2) long-term advanced intensive language programs.

The [Health Effects Institute](#) was chartered in 1980 as an independent research organization to provide high-quality, impartial, and relevant science on the health effects of air pollution.

To help advance that mission, HEI welcomes applications for the Walter A. Rosenblith New Investigator Award. Through the program, grants of up to \$500,000 over as many as three years will be awarded in support of research being conducted by early investigators on the health effects of air pollution. Research projects are often interdisciplinary in nature and span a range of scientific fields, including atmospheric science, epidemiology, exposure science, statistics, and toxicology. In considering potential research topics, applicants should be aware of HEI's current priorities (as described in the draft HEI Strategic Plan for the Health Effects of Air Pollution 2020-2025), which this year are focused on four key areas: multipollutant science; accountability and transparency; emerging technologies and fuels; and global health science.

HEI strongly encourages individuals who are underrepresented in environmental exposure and health research to apply and encourages all applicants to diversify their research teams by including underrepresented individuals, including those attuned to and knowledgeable about the communities in which the studies are taking place to the extent appropriate given the study location(s).

Scientists of any nationality holding a PhD, ScD, MD, DVM, or DrPH degree are eligible to apply.

Preliminary applications are due March 24. Upon review, selected applicants will be invited

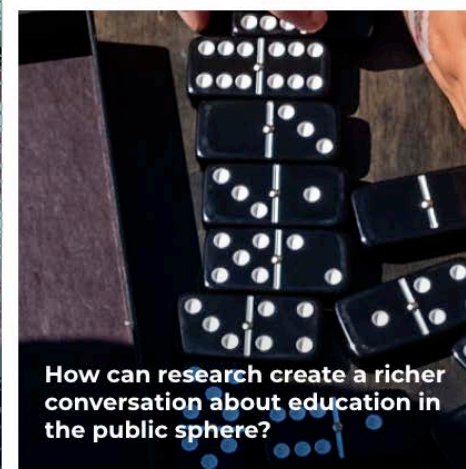

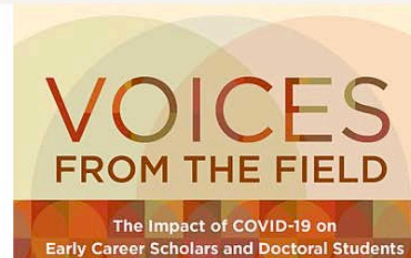
